As artists, we will be using David Hockney's work as inspiration when creating our own landscape paintings.



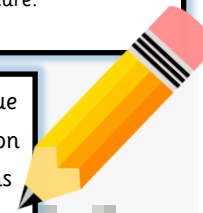
As historians, we will be explaining why the high street is so significant to Hull and using maps to describe the growth and development of the city as a trading place.

We will be writing a persuasive piece and an information text about a mythical creature.



As mathematicians, we will continue to look at multiplication and division before moving on to area, fractions and decimals.



In reading, we will be looking at how language is used in poetry, how to use a setting to create a theme and how an author creates a character.



In PSHE, we will be learning what it means to be resilient and looking how anxiety links to peer pressure.

In religion and world views, we will be exploring why people devote themselves to a cause. We will also be exploring the meaning of the cross and how it conveys the Easter message.



As geographers, we will be learning about the River Hull and how it has shaped Hull into the city it is today. We will also look at the features of rivers and how they are formed.



In PE, we will be creating a dance routine using various motifs and incorporating a range of movements.
